## Legal help on the way to seniors in Central Minnesota

The Central Minnesota Council on Aging is giving the St. Cloud office of Mid-Minnesota Legal Aid new funding dollars for 2025. This means seniors in Wright County will continue to have access to legal advice, counseling and representation in court and administrative hearings at no cost.

Residents of Wright County, 60 years of age and older, can get legal assistance with Medicare, Social Security, eviction or other housing problems, public benefits, such as medical assistance, food support and fuel assistance, family law issues, including domestic abuse and income maintenance, nursing home problems, home care services, powers of attorney, health care directives and debt collection. **NO** help is provided for criminal matters, wills, estate planning or real estate transactions.
